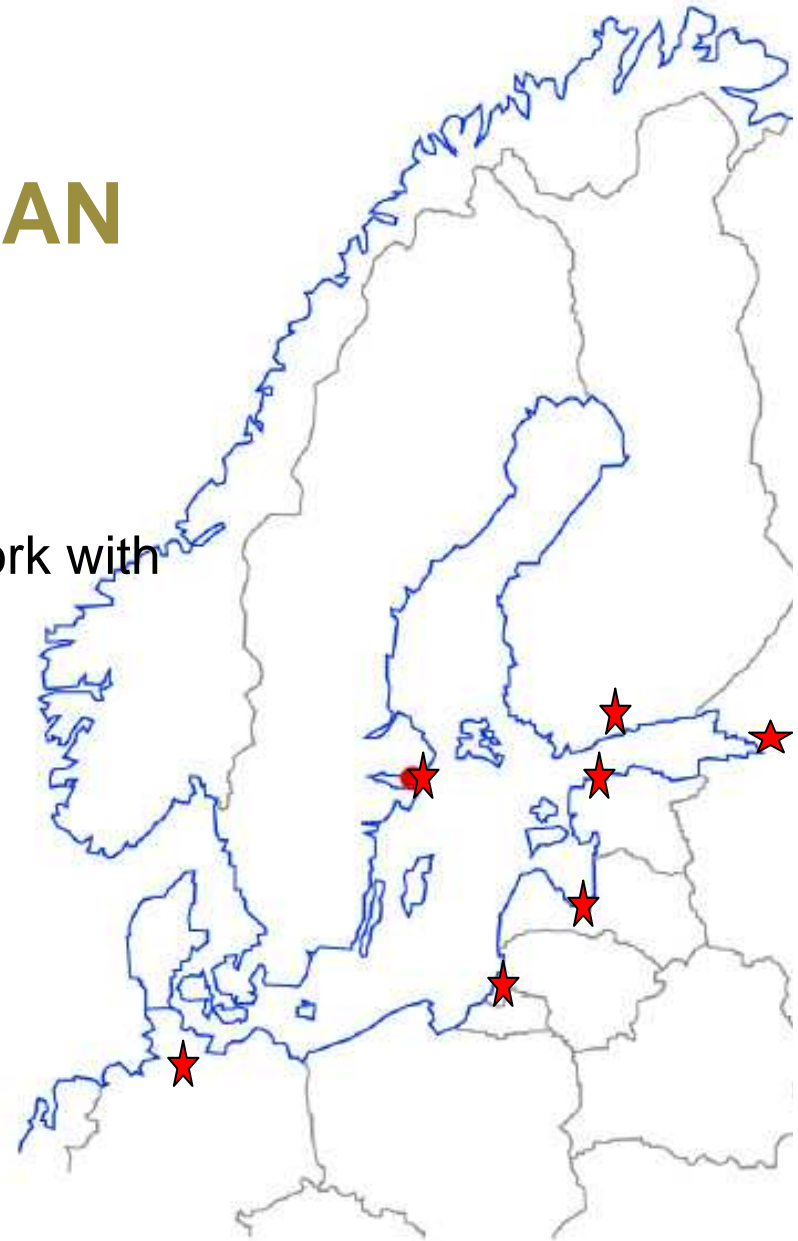

- Developed information exchange platform on the web, handbook on conflict resolution, shared experience and best practice in CZM with related Interreg projects.





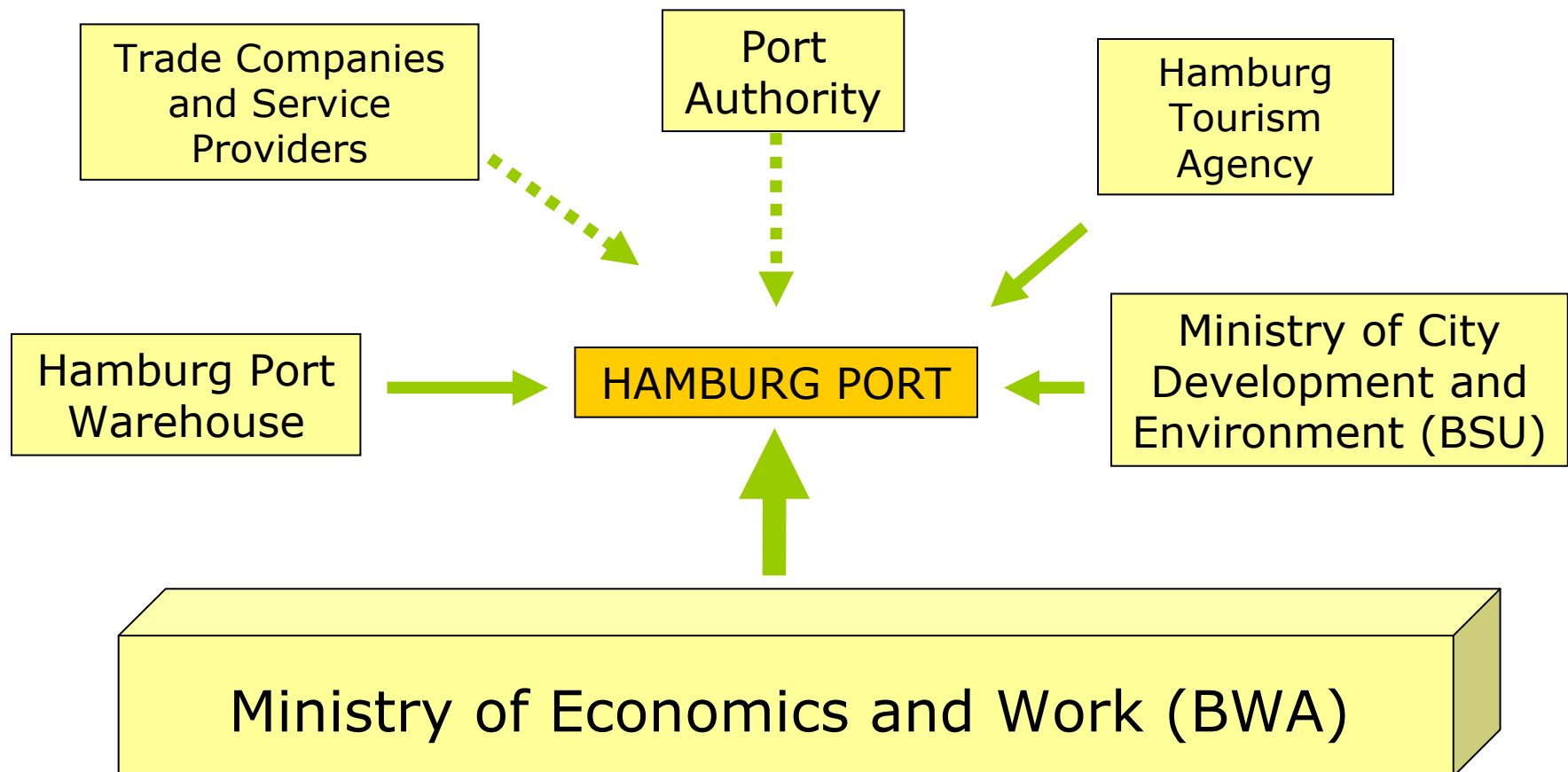
