

# syllabus of the training program

- Focus on conflict resolution in BSR according to coastal zone conflicts.
- No need of training program for CZM in general, so the focus of a training program should be conflict resolution according to the special international and national conditions in the BSR.
- The focus group of this training program is participants of our case studies, which means a broad map of stakeholders with different experiences.

It could be for example politicians, local and regional officers from municipalities or state organisations, managers/ officers from companies, NGO or people from university.

# syllabus of the training program

- 1. *Environmental Conflicts: background and basic knowledge***  
A general background and knowledge about environmental conflicts in general and specially according to Coastal Zone conflicts.
- 2. *Environmental Conflict Resolution (ECR): methods and tools.***  
A description and discussion about methods and tools used in environmental in work with environmental conflict resolution. Internet links and reference literature with examples from different case studies.
- 3. *Legislation and agreements important to the BSR and costal zone conflicts.***  
A description of the most important part of international law useful for the BSR and a briefly overview of differences in national laws around BSR important to understand costal conflicts.
- 4. *Five different case studies.***  
Here we will have a description of our cases studies based on our experiences from the COASTMAN project. Stockholm, Hamburg, Klaipeda, Ventsplis and Haapsalu.  
This means a description and a discussion about background, conflicts, methods of conflict resolution and results of case studies.  
Here we also can test different types of pedagogical methods to describe the cases, eg role play, scenarios.
